

Mrs. Steven Glover

Starrucca.—Our entire community was shocked to hear of the death on Saturday, of Mrs. Steven Glover. Although in poor health about a month Mrs. Glover had attended her usual household duties until her sudden death on Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock from a heart attack.

Mrs. Glover, who before her marriage was Mary Carpenter, a daughter of the late John and Minerva Carpenter, was born in Harmony Township and was 78 years old. On April 15, 1885 she was united in marriage to Steven Glover at Windsor, N. Y. and has resided in Starrucca the greater part of her life. Mr. and Mrs. Glover celebrated their golden wedding anniversary six years ago. She was a member of the Starrucca Methodist Church and a charter member of the M. E. Ladies Aid Society.

Besides her husband, Mrs. Glover is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Nellie Porter, of Hancock, N. Y.; five sons, Andrew Carl, Roy and Herman Glover of Starrucca and Dewayne Glover of Middletown; two sisters Mrs. Hattie Penn of Starrucca, and Mrs. Phoebe Knapp of Wellsbridge and one brother Charles Carpenter of Hancock, 22 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren. A daughter Esther died in 1918.
