Frank Karcher, 56, lifelong resident of Scott township, Wayne Co., died Tuesday at his home, the victim of a heart attack, according to Coroner Vernon Walsh, suffered while plowing in a field near his house.

Mr. Karcher was born on May 26, 1884, near Scott Center, a son of Mr. and Mrs. Christopher Karcher. He attended the local schools and followed the occupation of farming.
