The Petition of Catharine Riegel, Widow of John Riegel, late of Jefferson Township, Berks County, deceased, and Jonathan Riegel, Jacob Riegel, Daniel Riegel, Michael Riegel, Simon Riegel, and Abraham Riegel, sons and heirs at Law of the said John Riegel, deceased, and Daniel Strouse, Trustee of John Riegel another son and heir at law of the said deceased, and Joseph Blatt and Catharine his wife, late Catharine Riegel, daughter of the said deceased, Benneville Weber and Sarah his wife, late Sarah Riegel, daughter of the said deceased, Daniel Moyer and Veronica his wife, late Veronica Riegel, daughter of the said deceased, Elizabeth Riegel, Hannah Riegel, both daughters of the said deceased and Isaac Kantner, Guardian of Sarah Berger, Devilla Berger, John Berger and Elisa Berger, and Philip Degler Guardian of Louisa Berger, Rebecca Berger, Isaac Berger and Emelia Berger, minor children deceased, late Rebecca Riegel, who was also daughter of the said deceased. To the Honorable the Judges of the Orphans Court of Berks County. The undersigned appointed by your honorable court auditor to audit the account of Simon Riegel and Samuel M. Klee, Administrators of John Riegel late of Jefferson township Berks County, deceased, and make distribution among the heirs, begs leave respectfully to report:

That having given one notice, agreeably to the rules of your court, he attended at the time and place appointed, and several of the parties interested being present, he entered upon the discharge of the duties of his appointment.

He has examined the said account, together with the papers, vouchers, and other evidences thereto belonging, and has restated the same in the manner shown in the foregoing statement marked A. The restated account shows a balance in the hands of the administrators of Five Thousand four hundred and ninety four Dollars and five cents (\$5494.05); which your auditor has distributed in the manner shown in the foregoing statement marked **<u>B</u>**. In order to make a proper distribution, it became necessary to bring in the proceeds of the Real Estate of the said John Riegel; and in distribution B, your auditor therefore included the balance in the hands of Simon Riegel and Joseph Blatt, Trustees of the Real Estate of John Riegel, as the same appears in the Auditors Report upon the account of the Trustees aforesaid, filed on the same day with the present report.

At the request of some of the heirs, the auditor has added Statement **C**; which shows the indebtedness of the heirs to each other on account of lands accepted at the appraisement in the Orphans Court.

Excess of advancement

If Simon retains the amount due from him to Daniel, on account of land taken by the former, to wit \$166.22, and Daniel pays in addition, to the administrators the sum of \$82.81, he will have refunded to the estate his entire advancement and in all future distributions will be entitled to an equal share with the other heirs. If this is done, there will be an additional fund of \$249.03 to be distributed among Daniel's twelve brothers and sisters and their heirs. To wit \$20.7525 for each living brothers and sisters and \$2.59 for each of the ?? Berger children.

Jonathan owes Catharine, Jacob, Daniel, Rebecca's Heirs, Michael, Elisabeth, Sarah, Veronica, Hannah and John-\$29.4325 Rebecca heirs are each entitled to the sum of \$3.68.

Daniel, in addition to his advancement, owes the admns. for the three bonds of his, and interest, with which they are charged; the sum of \$567.44.

The administrators in their account took credit for \$277.11, balance due on the bond of his father to Jonathan. This the auditor has stricken out; as the bond was given, instead of money, as an advancement. The amount paid by the father on account of this bond viz \$284.34, is the actual advancement and is charged to Jonathan in the distribution.
