

KNOW all MEN,

by these Presents

That We *Michael Hansby of the Parish of Saint Augustine in the City and Diocese of Bristol Gentleman and Thomas Jones of the Parish of Saint James in the City & Diocese of Bristol Merchant* are held and firmly bound unto the Right Reverend

Father in GOD *Henry Reginald* by Divine Permission, Lord Bishop of *Bristol* in the Sum of One Thousand Pounds of good and lawful Money of Great-Britain, to be paid to the said Reverend Father, or his certain Attorney, Executors, Administrators, Successors or Assigns: For which Payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and every of us, jointly and severally, for and in the whole, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, and every of them, firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals,

Dated the *Twentieth* Day of *June* in the *thirty fifth* Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord *George the third* by the Grace of GOD, King of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, Defender of the Faith, and so forth, and in the Year of our LORD, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety *five*

THE CONDITION of this Obligation is such, That if hereafter there shall not appear any lawfull Lett or Impediment, by Reason of any Pre-Contract entered into before the Twenty-fifth Day of March, in the Year of our LORD One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-four, Consanguinity, Affinity, or any other legal Cause whatsoever, but that the above-bounden *Michael Hansby and Catharine Jones of the Parish of Saint Augustine aforesaid*

may lawfully solemnize Marriage together, And in the same, afterwards lawfully remain and continue for Man and Wife, according to the Laws in that Behalf provided. and moreover, if there be not at this Time any Action, Suit, Plaint, Quarrel or Demand, moving or depending before any Judge, Ecclesiastical or Temporal, for or concerning any such Lett or Impediment between the said Parties. And if it shall not appear that either of them be of any other Parish, or of any better Estate or Degree than to the Judge at the granting of the Licence is suggested and by the said *Michael Hansby* sworn to. And if the said Marriage shall be openly solemnized in the Parish Church of *Saint Augustine*

Augustine aforesaid in the Licence specified between the Hours appointed, in the Constitutions Ecclesiastical confirmed, and according to the Form of the Book of Common-Prayer now by Law established. And lastly if the above-bounden *Michael Hansby and Thomas Jones*

Michael Hansby and Thomas Jones do save harmless and keep indemnified the above-mentioned Right Reverend Father, his Vicar-General, and all other his Officers and Ministers whatsoever by Reason of the Premises, Then this Obligation shall be void, or else remain in full Force and Virtue.
