

## Alfred Adelbert Fancher

Alfred Adelbert Fancher, familiarly known to his many friends as "Del", died at his home on Wednesday of last week. Death came as an aftermath of injuries received in an accident at Cooks Falls on August 15th, when the car in which Mr. and Mrs. Fancher were returning home was in collision with a milk tanker.

Mr. Fancher was born in Pennsylvania on July 4, 1866. He was married to Dora Decker who survives him, and there were no children. He was an insurance agent, and an active member of the I. O. O. F. and the Maccabees.
