Mrs. Ervin E. Hackett

Laura W. Wolf, wife of Ervin Hackett, passed away at the family residence, 63 Grand Boulevard, Binghamton, at 6:00 a. m. Tuesday, July 14, 1942. A year ago Mrs. Hackett suffered a severe heart attack, rallied and was at home several months. About two weeks ago she reentered the City Hospital for further treatment. She was taken home only last Saturday when she was in her 76th year.

The Hacketts were Hancock residents for 30 years prior to 1912 when they moved to Binghamton. Mr. Hackett conducted a furniture and undertaking business, for some time associated with S. S. Busfield.

A daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Christian Wolf, Mrs. Hackett was born in South Sterling, Pa., Oct. 5, 1866. For several years she was a teacher in the schools of Wayne County. On Nov. 27, 1890, she married Ervin E. Hackett and after a few years they settled in Hancock, remaining there until 1912 with the exception of one year at Carlsbad, New Mexico.

The Hacketts also resided at Ott Center, Scott township, for many years in the Hackett home place, later owned by Bert Smith. Her husband was then proprietor of the Lakewood Feed Mills, which he established.

Mrs. Hackett leaves her husband and two sons, Edgar O., of Syracuse and Ray T., of Binghamton; also three grandchildren, Loren D., Stewart C. and Joyce Ann, children of her son and Mrs. Ray Hackett.

Older residents will remember Mrs. Hackett for her genial, friendly and Christian character. She was associated with the Presbyterian church and its auxiliary organizations. In Binghamton she was a member of the West Presbyterian church.

Services were held at the home on Thursday evening at 7:30, her pastor, the Rev. George W. Brown, officiating. A committal service for Hancock friends was held at 10 a. m. Friday at the family plot in Riverview cemetery, Hancock. She was a charter member of Chehocton Chapter, No. 327, O. E. S., of Hancock.
