

Mrs. Charles Roberts

Mrs. Charles Roberts died at her home in Starrucca Wednesday morning, March 7th, from a heart attack, after being in failing health the past four years. Mrs. Roberts, whose maiden name was Verna Edna Sampson, was born in Starrucca on May 19, 1878, a daughter of the late Sarah and David Sampson, and was 66 years, 10 months and 12 days old. She had lived her entire life in Starrucca. On Dec. 18, 1895, she was united in marriage with Charles Leroy Roberts, who survives, together with two foster sons, Sanford and Kenneth Furman, and three nieces, Mrs. Jenny Travis, Starrucca; Mrs. Bessie Tarbox, Deposit, and Mrs. Tressa Utter, Binghamton.
