

April Jay W. Sanford 45

Jay Wyatt Sanford, 65, of Shehawken, Wayne county, passed away at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Maynard Miller, Stanton St., Honesdale, at 5:10 o'clock Tuesday afternoon, April 17. Death followed an illness of some duration.

The deceased was born at Shehawken on Oct. 18, 1879, a son of the late James C. and Aspia (Haynes) Sanford. He was one of a family of eight children. He received his education in the local schools and at the Hotchkiss school, Lakeville, Conn., where he met and married Lily Roberts. Returning to Wayne county, Mr. Sanford took up the occupation of carpenter, which trade he had learned with his father. He resided at Shehawken, Binghamton, N. Y., Hohokus, N. J. and returned to Shehawken some twenty-four years ago where he purchased the W. H. Sanford property. He continued the work of contracting and building until last fall at which time he was constructing the High Point Mausoleum at Hancock, N. Y.
